We didn't do any thing this morning but this afternoon we went to the rifle range to fire our rifles. I just finished cleaning my rifle.

We're supposed to get paid this week. I don't know yet. I got a \$10 raise, you know. When we come overseas we get \$60 instead of \$50. And when I get my combat infantryman's fadge I'll get \$70. That's when we see action or after. Pretty good eh?

We got our clothes sack from the laundry today. I still have to get it. I hope it came out reasonably clean.

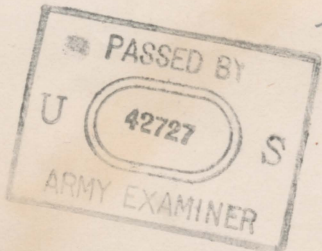
