Dear Mom and Pop,

I was pretty lucky yesterday. I was the extra man on guard so I didn't have to walk guard.

A lot of the boys are leaving our group. Two of my friends left already and it looks like there is going pretty soon too. I don't know when I'll leave yet. Not yet, anyway.

We went to the movies last night and I saw "None but the Lonely Heart" with Cary Grant. It was a very good picture. I think I'll go to the show tonight, too, but I don't know who's playing.

The weather today was first of bad. It started to sprinkle in the afternoon but soon quit. It's still cloudy so it may rain tonight.

We sort of fixed up the tent this afternoon. We brought in boxes for tables and shelves and made some stands for our candles. We have six men to a tent so we have plenty of room.

Our mail hasn't caught up yet so I
haven't the slightest idea what's up at home.
I hope everyone is O.K. I guess everybody is
waiting for mail call and pay day. We haven't
been paid yet. Since we're still restricted
with messes, we can't spend our money, anyway.
I only spent around \$3 since I came here.

Well, I guess this is all for today,
no more tomorrow
