The company went on a all day hike today but our tent didn't have to go. We had police detail - all we did was sweep the street and we were finished. I did a little laundry and then took it easy.

In the afternoon, I just read a bit and then fell asleep. That warm sun sure makes you feel lazy.

I haven't too much to write so I'm going to finish his letter later.

I just came back from the rec hall. They sell coffee and cookies for 10 lines so we always go after dinner.

I think we're going to the movies tonite. I've been going almost every night. The movies are fairly good. Most of them are a little old but there's a lot of them I didn't see so I enjoy it.

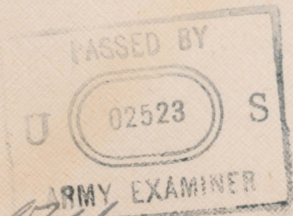
