Dear Mom and Pop,

I moved again. I have a new temporary
APO number again too. It's —

PVT TISHIDA —

SERVICE Co. (PROV.) 442ND INF REGT

APO 464 c/o PM NEW YORK, N.Y.

We'll be in this new camp for a little
while anyway.

Well, as soon as I met John I
left him. He didn't come with us.

Just in case you don't know, I'm in
the 5TH Army.

We're now sleeping in pup tents. We're
in a nice grove of trees so it's pretty
nice.

I'm not assigned yet so I still don't
know what my real APO is, so I just have
to keep sending you a new APO every time I
move.

We came over here on trucks so we saw
the country side as we came. Most of the
towns we passed were badly shelled by artillery
fire.

We're still pretty far from the front
lines so there isn't any cause for you

to worry. Of course, every time we
move we get a little closer but we're
still not there yet.

Our mail still isn't worth so. I gave
up guessing when it's going to come.

I met Hank Finken a little while
ago. He left about 5 days before me.
I guess John will be up here soon too.

I guess this is about all for today
so more tomorrow.

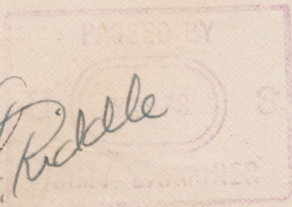
