April 25, 1945

Dear Mom and Pop,

We had a good sleep last night. Our put tents are luxury compared to sleeping out in the open.

I didn't do much today. John and I talked a good part of the morning and in the afternoon, we went down to a small stream and took a bath. I did my laundry there too.

The weather is pretty good so it's ~~so~~ nice out here. We just loaf around.

I got a haircut from a Italian barber this morning. He comes to our bivouac area every day. A haircut is ten lire (10¢) and a shave is five lire, cheap?

I don't think I'll get my mail until I'm assigned to a company so I'll just have to wait. I hope you're getting my letters regularly. I try to write as often as possible but when you don't hear from me a couple of days, don't worry.

This is about all for today so more tomorrow,

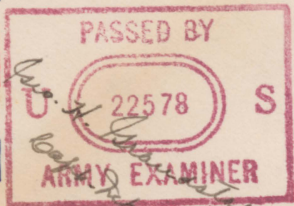
