Dear Mom and Pop,

Last night we had mail call and I got your letters from you and also that box of candy. I also received a letter from Foni. Yours letters were post marked 17th, 18th, 19th and 20th. Foni sent her letter on the 19th. I got some stamps in one of the letters too.

It's nice to hear what's going on back home. Kind of made me laugh about Fohie getting angry because she didn't hear from her husband when he left for basic. I can remember the time I left for camp but that seems a long time ago.

I hope you received the GI paper I sent you. Do me a favor, will you? If there is any items about the 442nd in the papers save them till I get back. I'll appreciate it.

I guess you know by now that the war here has ended. This means that a lot of the boys are going home. I think our outfit will be loafing about here for a little time. From today on, we started garrison training. That's to keep us occupied I guess. It's something like the beginning our basic training only easier because it's not so strict.

You asked me to write requests now and then so you can send me something. Well, right now I don't need anything but I'll

write one down so you can send me any thing
you want.

I REQUEST You  A BOX OF CANDY.

Some of the boys  to Geneva today so
I'll probably get one pretty soon. I'll tell you
all about it, if I go.

Boy, everyone was shooting off flares and
rifles last night because the war ended. I
think we're luckier than other fellows because I
don't think they'll send us to the Asiatic Theater. I
guess all of us feel that way.

We're not doing any thing this afternoon so
I thought I'd write you a letter. Will you say
hello to every one for me? I don't feel like writing to
people (too lazy) and you're about the only one I write
to so I'll depend on you.

Well, this is about all for today so I'll
write more tomorrow

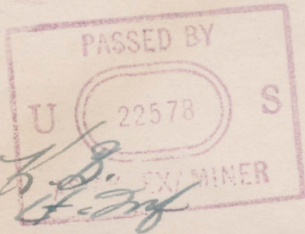
