Dear Howard Boy,

I received 5 letters from you the day before yesterday and also 3 yesterday.

I went to Genoa all day yesterday so I didn't write to you. Boy, we had a lot of fun. I went with a buddy. He was a neighbor of Miyasaka before the war. We went to all the shops and all over the city. It's really a nice place. Of course, we had a little trouble trying to make the people understand us but we know just a little Italian so that helped us out. Boy, I really bought a lot of stuff. I bought a box camera there so I'll take some pictures and send them to you as soon as I can. I bought some post cards and stuff so when I get them wrapped up, I'll send them to you. I bought Pop a bag of Italian stamps. I hope he likes them.

I guess by the time this l. t. reaches you, you'll know that the war in Europe has officially ended. That's really good news to all of us. I kind of regret the President didn't live just a little longer to see the end of it.

You said that Kazji-san is coming out to

Salt Lake to find a place to live. Well, I hope
he finds a place and a nice job. I'd feel much
better when I know everything is settled down.

We got our PX rations today. Boy, my
bag is full of candy and stuff now. They gave us
free too so I traded it with things I wanted.

Well, this is about all for today so
I'll write again tomorrow,
