I went swimming yesterday and I went again today. The lake is a big one, it makes Salt Lake look like a mud puddle. The water is warm and so clear you can see down around 20 to 30 ft. We rented a row boat and rowed all around the place. There's a town right next to the lake so we bought some cherries. They're 30 lire (30¢) for one kilo. I sent a couple of pictures of the town and lake in another envelope.

I'm going to the movies now. We have movies every night except on Sundays.

I'm sending a request for something, use it when you have something to send. So far, no packages reached me except a box of candy so I'll get a lot of packages.

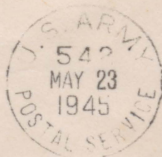
I'm going to go see Bob after the movies. He's just a couple of hundred of yards away. Well, more tomorrow.
