Dear Mom and Pop,

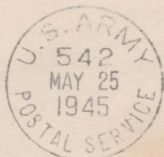
I got 3 letters from you today. They were May 7, 10, and 12. One had a snapshot of you. Thanks very much. Boy, did lots of you gain weight!
