Dear Mom and Pop,

I'm getting your letters almost everyday. I got two today, one was April's and one was May 16. I also got two from Tomi and two from Frank Okoyati.

I didn't do much today. We had a rehearsal parade this morning for the band. This afternoon I took a shower.

We went to the movies last night but it started to sprinkle so the same one is on tonight.

Boy, I'm gaining weight again. Doing nothing and eating good food sure adds weight. You see, we have our own cooks and he makes what we like. Just for the 442nd, we get rice instead of potatoes so we have rice once or twice a day. Yesterday we had chicken (fried), peas and rice and salad, ice tea and ice cream with fresh strawberries. Today we had miku-nabe with vegetables and rice, ice lemonade and pineapples. Pretty good, eh?
