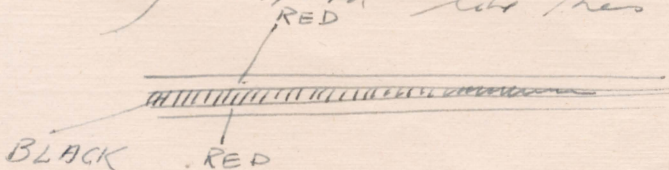
May 27, 1945

Dear Mom and Pop,

I have another favor to ask of you. I hate to cause you so much trouble. You remember I asked you to send me a overseas cap a couple of weeks ago. Well, since then my orders came through and I have another color on my hat again. You remember I wore blue on the cap before and I wore the crossed rifle of the infantry on my lapel. Well, I'm in the ADJUTANT GENERAL'S OFFICE now and wear a different color a lapel button. The button is something like this -



The color on my hat is red and black. You know where the color band on the edge of the cap is don't you? Well - the color band is red with a black stripe running lengthwise all along the band - like this -



I'm asking you again to send me a cap. The size
is 7 1/8

CAP AND CANDY

I hope you can find one like that because
there aren't very many in the adjutant general's office.
Next time when you go downtown see the label on the
soldiers and see if you can see anyone wearing
that kind of a button.
