Dear Mom and Pop,

I didn't write yesterday because we were kind of busy for a change. Yesterday morning and this morning we played for the boys that are going home. There's just a few old timers that are going home. Yesterday afternoon, a buddy and I sneaked off to Brescia. There's a regular bus line going there but a officer checks your pass at the door of the bus when you get on so we went down the road and waited for the bus. I guess no one had a pass because when the bus stopped for us half the group got on where we did. After all that trouble when we got to town we learned it was a religious holiday and all the stores were closed. I got two of your letters a few days ago. It was May 21, 22. It only took 8 days to get here. Fast!

We had a USO show last night. It was a small group but it was pretty good. They had a comedian, a singer and a girl comic.

I had some pictures taken again and as
soon as it's developed I'll send it to you.
It might take a long time to develop because
everyone is taking pictures. I left some film
in town too. If I sneak off to town today
I'll pick them up.
