Tomorrow is pay day so I'm anxiously waiting for my hard earned pay.??

You said that you were going to buy a handbag. Do so right away. But tell me what kind you like and the

color. If you have any ideas draw
~~me~~ me a rough picture. I can't promise
you but I may be able to get one you
like in town. Now, don't say you don't
want it! Tell me in your next letter and
be sure about it.

I hope Pichan liked the stamps I
sent home. I guess you didn't get the
package I sent Lomi yet from Alton.
It had pictures and stamps in them.

I'm getting to airmail stamps regularly
so thanks.

Well, more tomorrow

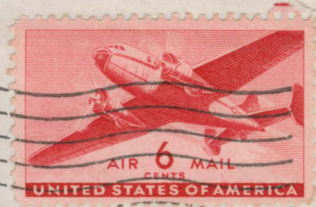
