Sept 24, 1944

Dear Mom and Pop,

Well, here it is Sunday again. I just got up and took a shower. I didn't eat my breakfast yet, so I'm going over to the Service club to get a bite to eat.

Last night, I think I told you all ready, we went to the movies to see Sweet and Low-Down with Benny Goodman and his orchestra. The music was just swell. We enjoyed it very much. We're not gettingy passed this week so I guess we'll go next week. By the way, we get paid next Saturday for one month and a half.

It seems that every thing I write to you, I ask you for something. You probably get mixed up what to send. Well, here I go again. I don't know whether you forgot or not, but I asked you to send me some heavy wool socks of any solid color. Don't get red or that kind of color, but something like light gray or tan or plain white. When we go on long walks, heavy socks will protect the feet.

It's still morning and I don't have much to write about so I'll finish this letter at night. We don't know what we'll do this afternoon, but I think we'll go swimming.

1:00 PM

I just received your letter of Sept 21. In the first page I asked whether you forgot the socks but after re-reading your letter, I see that you didn't.

It's really funny when you tell me that you saw this picture or that one, because compared with the shows here, it's pretty old. "Rainbow Island" was playing here a long time ago. I think we'll go see "Kismet" tonight. It's starring actors are Ronald Colman and Marlene Dietrich (is that the right way?).

We're not going swimming this afternoon because of the bad weather.
