I went into Milano yesterday. I went with Art. We saw the famous cathedral, and all the sights. I bought a cameo for you, Mom. I hope you like it. Maybe you can find a frame for it and have a brooch made. Some of the cameos had frames put but it wasn't too good so I just bought the stone alone. I'm also sending some pictures of Milano and the bracelet I bought for you in Novi. I'm sending the package today.

I received two packages today. It had can goods and underwear. The other had candy, papers and dock glasses and the cuffon stone. Looks very much. I'll read them, Lady so they'll come in handy.



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It took us about one hour and forty five minutes to go to Milano. The city is just like any other American cities. It's just as big as Chicago and little stores are every where. We walked all around and looked into every store. The church is really beautiful. It's all stone and marble. Inside the decorations are silver and gold.

It must have cost a pretty penny. It was built around 1369, so it's pretty old.

We're moving out this Friday or Saturday to another place, so if you don't hear me for one or two days, don't worry. I think we're going to Lake Como. That's on the map. It's in the upper part of Italy near Switzerland.
