I didn't do much today. In the afternoon we went to Secco and had cold drinks. Later on we went over to Lake Secco and rented a row boat. Art and I went walking around the neighborhood tonight but we came back early.

I went to the movies last nite and saw the movie "Laddie, Son of Lassie". It's the story of a dog and it was in Technicolor. It was a good show and it was pretty ter.

I'm starting at the bugling class tomorrow. I'm to teach some of the boys how to blow bugles. So far we haven't played for any dances. I hope the fund comes back pretty soon.

I was talking with John and Chester at the show last night. They're camping about  $\frac{1}{4}$  of a mile away.

I'm sending some post cards of Secco.
