I'm going downtown tomorrow and see if my films are ready. I hope they are.

Boy, our food here is really good. It's better than the other companies because we're service company and the supplies come here first before going to the other areas.

The other day we had "tempura" and "niku-nate". Today we had real good chop suey with green peppers, meat, water cress, celery and pineapple. Boy, it sure was good. We get rice once or twice a day.

The singing class is coming along O.K. I'm teaching them some of the marches we used to play in Troop 12.

That hat you sent is pretty good. I took the red fringed off (a Italian did) so it looks like an officers hat. I hope I'll get the lost hat you sent soon.

I'm going to the movies tonight. Last night we went down to town and had ice with flavoring on it. You remember when I was a little kid I used to buy it.

I didn't tell you before but I picked up a German pistol quite a while back ago. It's not too big so it'll make a nice souvenir. ~~It's not too big~~ I can't mail it home but I can bring it back when I go home so Do-chen will just have to wait until I get home to see what it looks like. It's a automatic.
