Dear Mom & Pop,

Well, loafing again. It's raining this morning so I'm on the grandstand (we're next to a soccer field & there's a grandstand). There's a roof on top so no rain gets in. I've been playing my horn.

I found out we're not going tomorrow but we're moving out on Thursday (12th) to Leghorn (Livorno).

I guess Aunt Jenni is out by now or at least she will be by the time this letter reaches you.

I have a favor to ask you. Will you send some of my music to me. You know the music note book.

Bill Wehara returned to you. Please send that to me. Also the next time you go downtown go to the magazine shop on 2nd South a faint $\frac{1}{4}$ of a block down from Main St. and buy me a couple of music sheets. It costs 35¢ a copy. Ask the lady for the most popular ones. Try & get the song "CANDY". If she doesn't have it, it's alright. I'll write the request below.

It just stopped raining so I'm going back to my tent. I guess we're all having funny weather this year.
