I'm guarding the prisoners who come to work in our area. All I have to do is watch them and I carry my carbine (small rifle). The Jerry prisoners work in the kitchen as KP, at the supply tent and all the other places where help is needed. I also flew the horn for the company. I played retreat tonite.

I'm getting your letters regularly but I didn't get a package yet.

I haven't very much to write about so more tomorrow —
