Dear Mom and Top,

I just got my baggage from the freight car so I'm writing a ltr. to you.

We moved out on Thursday at 7:00 AM. I went on a shower unit truck with Art. There were only 3 on the truck so we had a lot of fun all way down.

We passed thru Milano, Genoa, La Spezia and we came here around 11:00 PM.

We're about 6 or 7 miles south of Pisa and 10 miles from Leghorn. The regiment is guarding prisoners here. I don't have much to do yet.

Dear Mom and Pop

I forgot to mail the letter yesterday
so I'm sending it in with today's.

A fuddy and I didn't have
anything to do yesterday so we
hitch-hiked to Florence. About 70 miles.
Army trucks are numerous so we didn't
have any trouble getting there. We spent
the day looking around town. Some of it
was shelled pretty badly, but the ~~the~~
main part of town wasn't damaged
too badly.

I'm helping to supply sergeant today
no more later on. More tomorrow.
