I'm glad to hear that you liked  
the packet I sent you.

Thanks for Joni's new address.  
I'll have to write to her.

I'm still guarding the prisoners. All  
I do all day is get the prisoners and  
then I read or sleep in my tent until  
it's time to bring them back.

By the way, we're sleeping in big  
tents, five men to a tent. We have  
cots too.

We got our PX today. I got  
lots of candy and we also got 6  
bottles of cokes. I got far too so  
I traded it for more cokes.

There isn't too much to write about  
because I do the same stuff all  
the time. I guess it's the same with  
you. Tomorrow the Andrew Sisters  
are coming here for a 450 show. I'm  
going to go see them.

I'm going to take some pictures  
in Pisa soon and I'll send them  
to you.
