I went to Lucca and then to Pisa yesterday. I went with a buddy of mine. We didn't stay in Lucca long because there was nothing doing there. In Pisa we went to the Leaning Tower of Pisa. We went all the way up to the top. We took a lot of pictures so when they're ready I'll send them to you.

I bought some stamps for 10-cen. Some are German and the rest are Netherland. I bought some Italian and German coins too. I'll send these when I pack them.

We came back early so that night we went to a USO show. The Andrew Sisters were there. The surprise guest was Arthur Treacher. You know him - he's that tall skinny guy that always

play the part of a English futher in the movies. He seem was funny. You know, he has that funny English accent.

The Andrew sisters were very good too. They sang a lot of songs that they recorded.

All in all, I had a very nice time yesterday.

When I came back there was two packages from you. One had magazines and candy and the other had stationery, one piece of rocks and a box of cookies and candy. Thanks very much.
