I haven't been doing much lately. Just guard prisoners.

I'm going to Florence tomorrow. I thought I'd take a day off so I asked the sergeant and he said OK. I can go get a pass any time I want, you know. The sergeant and I get along, you see.

Mom, do me a favor and send me my olive drab shirt. You know, the one I bought while I was in Blanding. I might be getting a 5 day pass one of these days and it'll come in handy. If you can, send the pants too.

I hope it isn't too much trouble.
I'll write the request below.
