Dear Mom and Pop,

I received another package from you today. It had magazines, crackers and a box of jam. The little jars of jam look so nice I don't feel like eating them.

I got a letter from Frank Moruoka today. Also one from Frank Ohayaki. He's in Seattle now.

I got news today. When I finished eating at noon, the lieutenant came over and asked me if I wanted to go to a veterinary school. We had a education classification about a month ago and I signed for veterinary. Well, anyway, I said yes so I'm going soon. Three men from the 442 regt is going and I'm one of them.

I don't know when I'm going or where.
I think it's the hospital about 40 miles
from here. I'll probably go at the end of
this week. It's about a four weeks
course. At least, I'll be learning
my trade, eh?

I'll keep writing everyday so
you'll know when I'm going. It's
~~not~~ no military secrets so I'll let
you know before I leave.

The 442 is going home next year so
I guess I'll study a little ~~and~~ learn
a little before I get back.
