at least once a day too.

I'm sending a request again:

Don't send candy this time because  
I'm getting too much now. When I  
was training and in the line I ate  
a lot of candy 'cause I got tired  
but now days I don't do much so  
I don't eat as much.

I hope Konji-san and his family  
is getting along O.K. Say hello to them.
