Well, here I is. I'm going to school again.

In the mornings, I go to the hospital and watch or help the doctors treat the horses and mules. In the afternoons, I go to two lectures and I'm finished. I start in the morning at 9:00 AM and finish lectures at 3:00 PM. I have one hour for lunch.

I'm learning to ride a horse too. I go riding every day for about 1½ hours. It's pretty easy, only I got a sore end. But I can still sit down.

I can go to town every night and take off Saturday afternoon and come back on Sunday night at 12.

Today at the Hospital I helped
the doctor (a captain) give a horse
a anti tentanus injection.

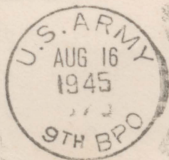
This afternoon, instead of lectures
