I received your Sept 25's letter. You mentioned a font the pen, but when I first wrote with it, the pen was still new so it didn't write too good. It writes OK now. Don't you think so?

In your letter, you mentioned a font the grenades. Well, I'll tell you again that it's not dangerous at all and you don't have to worry. Anyway, we won't handle the stuff anymore. We're finished with that class.

My money is still holding out pretty good. Since we didn't get a pass last week, I don't have much things to spend on. I haven't broken the \$20 bill and this Saturday is pay day, so I'm well off.

Gee, did we have it easy today.

You see, a General Lehr (a divisional

commander) was supposed to come and visit this camp today so we had to clean up. But he didn't arrive today. Maybe Friday. Well, anyway, we had to be ready for him. In the morning, we set up stands, for sitting, for the review. Then in the afternoon, we went back to our cabins to clean up the area. All we did all afternoon was sit in back of our cabins, where it's shady, and pulled out weeds. We finished early, ate our dinner, then took a shower, then we went to the movies.
