Dear Mom and Pop,

Since my change of address, the letters haven't caught up with me so I'll just have to wait.

Yesterday was supposed to be a half a day work but we got the whole day off. Today is a whole day. In the morning yesterday we went horse back riding. I'm getting pretty used to it now. On week days we spend the mornings in the vet hospital. We help put bandages on horses and mules and watch doctors treat the animals.

This afternoon, the three of us are going out to the beach. A bus goes there regularly. It's about 15 miles away.

We met a family out there and  
we're invited for dinner tonite.  
On week days we go over there at night  
and talk until around 10:00 PM. The  
bus leaves then.

magazines again.

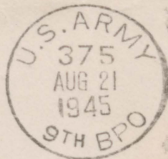
