I just came back from the hospital. They shot a horse this afternoon because she had a bad leg. The Jap prisoners are cutting it up to eat. We were watching them cut it up.

We went to town last night and went over to our Italian friend's family. We talked and listened to the radio.

I'm writing another request. I hope I'm not sending too many, but I forget sometimes if I sent one during the week or not.

Well, how's everybody back home
feel about the war's end? Was
there much celebration? I heard in
New York they had a riot and people
were killed. I know some soldiers
over here were killed celebrating when
they heard the news. That's foolish
getting killed after every thing ended.

now, so I'll write again
tomorrow
