I have a stamp for Pop again. Something new. Tell him that around September 28, a new three cent stamp is coming out, honoring the Army.

I got my PX today. Got lots of stuff now.

The way the discharge system is working, looks like Bob and Jack will be home pretty soon. I don't know how I stand but you can guess I'll be one of the last ones.

But one thing, I'm pretty sure I'll be home
for my next birthday.

I haven't too much to write about.
The captain lets us do more and more
treatments with the horses and mules
because we're getting used to it and learning
pretty fast. Even you stay with horses,
you begin to like them just like dogs. Well,
anyway, I like animals and that's only
my opinion.

This work is going to come in hardy
later on, though.
