Mom, I think you better write my letters to Service Company so they can send my letters up. I don't know what's happening but I'm not getting my letters.

I think one of these days we can
get a couple of days off so we're
planning to go down to Rome. It's about
110 miles south from here so we can get
down there in about 3 hours by truck.
I hear Rome is a nice place.

We're having Indian summer out here.
It's cool in the evenings but during the
day it's just right.
