I just came back from class. I haven't received any letters from you for a long time now. I think the post office is sending it to the wrong place. I'll get it pretty soon.

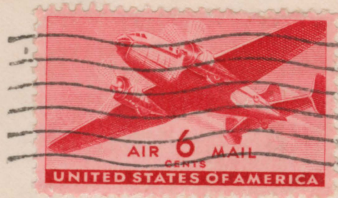
It rained for the first time on Sunday and Monday. It cleared up last night so we went to town.
