Dear Mom and Pop,

I moved up to Pisa yesterday afternoon. We're 2 miles out of Pisa. My room (there's 3 guys in each room - nice eh?) has a view of the "leaning tower".

I went back to my company and learned that Jake went home already. Well, that's good news. I picked up my films because Art went to Lenti-tank company. Frank (the one in the picture is still there and so is Mitani. The pictures were taken a couple of weeks before I went to school.

Oh I got 27 letters from you and 2 packages. I also had letters from different friends and one from Tomi, Bill Walton, Grandpa and John Mijasaki. The packages had magazines, "novi" and "o-books" and stationery. Boy, I hit the jack pot. The letters addressed to Remount were sent to my company and

they didn't know where to send it so  
they kept it here. Well, I'm going after the  
mail after this so it's OK. Just write to  
Service Co.

You said you're thinking of buying a car  
and go back to California. Well, I'm in  
favor of that. I hope you can go in the near  
future. The only thing I have to say about  
it, is, if you're going by car, take your time  
and be careful.

I have some copies of the history of  
the 442 that I'll send soon. It's a complete  
history of us up to now.
