Dear Mom and Pop,

Well, here it is the first of another month. I went to my company to get my pay yesterday. I got \$68.50. This is my usual pay from now on. I'm getting \$74 minus my insurance.

I ate dinner over at my company last night. We had pork chops, chop suey and hot rice. I wish I had brought that "thief's sack" with me.

I don't know what I'll do today. Tomorrow may be PX day so after we get our ration we may go on a pass to some city. It's not definite yet. I hope you got the stamps I sent to -chan. I mailed in two envelopes because it was too heavy for one.

There isn't too much to write about. Oh, yes, Katsumi Kawaguchi re-enlisted a couple of days ago. He'll go home on a

60 days furlough and then <sup>go</sup> to the Pacific.  
It's a three year hitch with another 60 days  
furlough at the end of a year and a half.  
You'd think he had enough of Army without  
reenlisting. All I want to do is get out of  
the Army and stay out.

I hope that sweaters will come soon.  
It's getting chilly these days. I guess  
winter is coming on.

I'm writing a request again.
