I'm trying to save a little money at present (very hard to save around here) so I can buy a watch when I get back home. I put away \$70 all ready. I

this

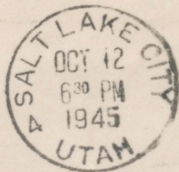


If I stay in services
