Dear Mom and Pop,

I'm going into Pisa this morning and see if I can get my name engraved on the fuzeelet.

Thursday
10:00 AM

Oct 4, 1945

I went into town yesterday before I finished this letter so I'll mail it today. My fuzeelet will be ready tomorrow. I had my name and serial number and 442 INF REGT engraved on the front and on the inside the motto "Go For Broke".

For we ate at service company at noon and then we went to Leghorn to see a movie. There's about 4 or 5 theaters here for GI's and they show the latest American movies. (Free). After the show we ate at Min's company and then we hitch hiked back here.

We were issued winter clothing yesterday. Overcoats, sweaters, underwear, cap, and gloves. I hate to disappoint you but it looks like we'll be here in Italy for a little while yet.

Our APO number changed. It was APO 464 but now it's APO 782. That's this area's number, so write your letters to this new one.

I didn't have any mail yesterday. All come in soon.

I'm going back to my company this Saturday. The long vacation is over. I might try for the GI University in Florence if I have a chance to go. I may as well get all I can while I can.
