I'm still at present waiting for orders.

I went to service company and found 11 letters for me. They were all September's. You told me to write to Aunt Toni's address and that you bought a 1939 Pontiac and you were leaving it just of this month. I didn't get your letter till yesterday so I kept writing to 434 Birch Way. I hope you told Mrs Frank to send my letters to Toni.

I haven't received any packages yet. Since the war ended, there isn't as many ships going overseas as before so every thing takes time.

I hope you had a nice trip back
to California. You were lucky to get 2
new tires for your car. I know they're
hard to get. You said in your letter
when I get home you're going to get

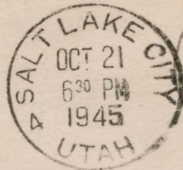
