Dear Mom and Pop,

I thought we'd go back to our companies today but our orders weren't in yet so we'll probably go back on Monday.

I went, we went, & left here this afternoon. First we stopped at Service Co. I picked up my mail. I had 3 letters from you. Did you find a car yet?

We were issued captured German sleeping bags today. It's all made out of goat or some kind of skin. The outside has fur on it and the inside is smooth. We can keep these because they're not G.I. Maybe I'll take one home. I went to service company and got another one so I have two. I'm going to try to have a jacket made out of one of them. It'll be warm.

We went to a show in Leghorn.  
We saw "Lady On A Train" with  
Deanna Durfen.

I hope what you say is true about the  
44<sup>th</sup> I going home around February. We  
don't know too much here, In fact, you know  
just as much as we do, maybe more.

Coming home we ate a service company.  
We had something of potato, vegetables and  
rice, and pineapples.

Well, this is a part all for now so  
see tomorrow.

I wrote to Bill We Hora and sent  
him one of the pictures I sent you. His  
address is 3043 SUMMIT ST - OAKLAND 9, CALIF.

Well, as I said before, see you!
