Dear Mom and Pop,

I went to a movie last night. We saw "George White's Scandals with Joan Davis and Jack Haley. It was a good comedy.

I'm still here at remount. I'm not complaining. All I do is loaf all day long. We get up late in the mornings (I just got up about 15 minutes ago) and in the afternoons we either sleep or go to Leghorn to see a show. Pretty easy life, eh? I wonder if Toni sent that letter to you from me about the \$20.00. I sent the letter to 1434 so I don't know if you got it or not. I'd like to have about \$20 in American money because I may go to Switzerland. With \$20 American money I can buy a watch worth about 80 francs. If I don't go I'll have the money changed to Italian money and then

send it home to you by money order. You see I can get  $2\frac{1}{2}$  for 1 for American currency here. That way if you sent \$20, I can get \$50 for it and when I change it to money order, it'll still be \$50.

By the way, let me know if you find a house you like. Let me know if you plan to stay there a long time or not because I have to change the address on my records and insurance and that's a lot of trouble just to go changing it for a temporary address.
