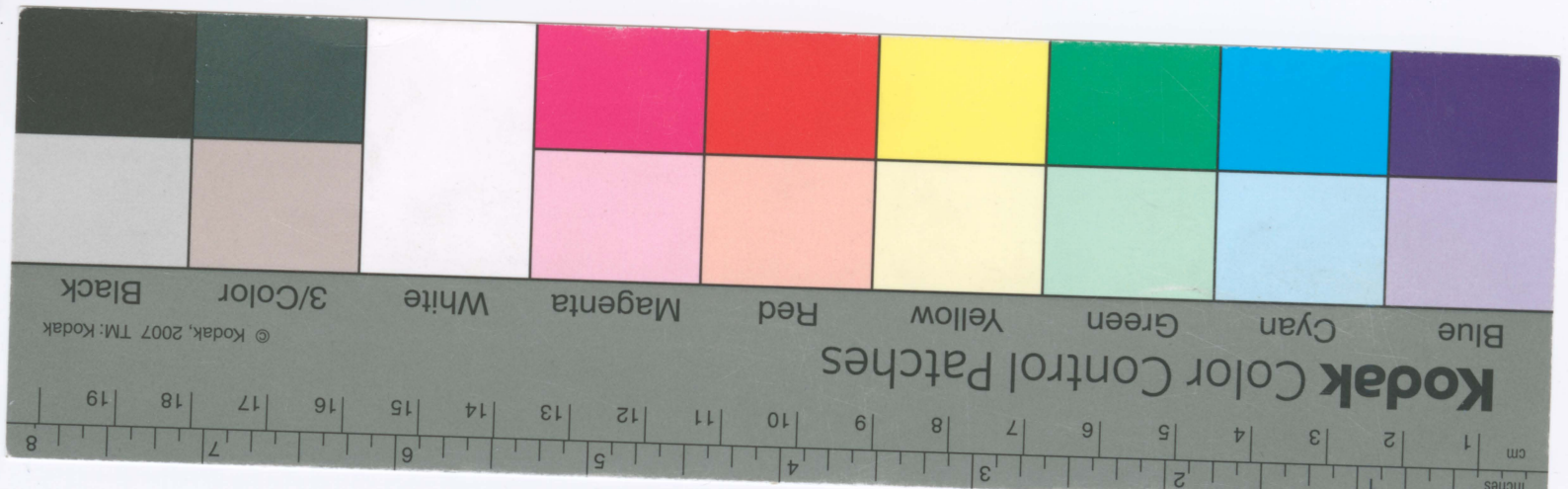
I got my PX at noon & have plenty of
