Dear Mom and Pop,

Well, another day and I'm working as usual. The colonel is around the area this morning so we have to be careful. I hope he doesn't come into the office.

There isn't too much to write about yet so I'll finish this letter a little later when the mail comes in.

No letters today. I think I'll get some tomorrow.

I took some pictures yesterday so as soon as I have them developed I'll send them to you. This morning when I went for the papers, I couldn't find the jeep so I took the ton and a half. I had a little trouble at first but as soon as I got use to the gear shift I did all right. The truck is easier to drive than the jeep because it holds the road better.
