I'm making this letter short because dinner will soon pretty ready. I hope I get some white meat. Is it hard to get turkey back home? I imagine things are pretty settled by now.

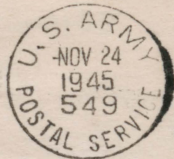
I brought the films I took to the film lab so it should be ready soon.
