It looks like we'll be home on February. Of course, it's not sure but it's around that time. I hope that isn't too long for you.

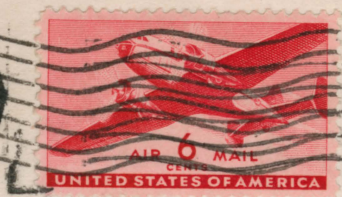
I want or I should say I ran the
