

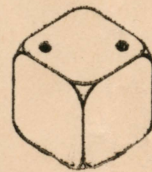
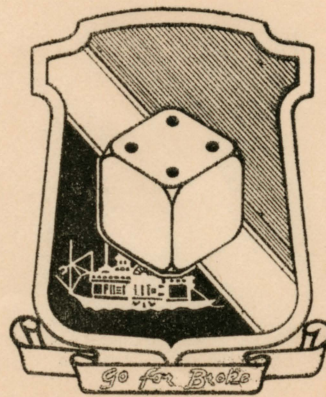
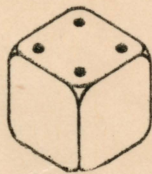

I received two letters from you today. I hope the photograph you sent will come soon.

Yesterday, three of us took the captain's jeep (he's up Switzerland) and went all over. We started in the morning and came back 5:00 in the afternoon. We went to our old bivouac area when we first came to Italy. We went up the mountain where we were fighting the series. I went to the place where I was a stretcher bearer too. We ate lunch at a Italian restaurant near Massa. We had spaghetti and half cooked Italian style. It was good and the price was reasonable for Italy. It cost us \$3.00 a piece. We sure had a lot of fun.

It rained all afternoon today. I went after the movie for tonight and boy, it sure was cold driving that car.

I'm glad to hear you see so many of your old friends. By the time I get home, there should be quite a few.

I hope you received the money order by now. Let me know right away when you get it. It's a Christmas present for both of you, you know. The watches will be sent later or just be patient.
