Dear Mom and Pop,

I received five letters yesterday, so I'm satisfied.

I went over to the dentist this afternoon. He found nothing wrong. I just went for a check up. Since I'm special service for this company I arranged to have a horse back riding party Sunday morning. About 8 of us and 2 Red Cross girls are going. I hope it's nice weather that day.

I'm sending you the watch and the clock home pretty soon. I had a box made so it's packed good. I bought a ash tray with the 442 sign on it. It'll be ready this Friday so I'll send it with the watch. I have a clasp and another bracelet for you too. I hope you like it.

I sent a lot of books and pamphlets just the other day. Let me know when you get it.

Well, this is about all for today so I'll write more tomorrow,
