Our movies here are pretty new. The captain said it was allright to use the jeep tonight. He better say O.K. There isn't very much to write about today because I didn't do very anything today.

I have the watch and the other stuff all packed up. Don't worry about anything breaking, because I packed everything in saw dust. There's a ash tray and your clock and bracelet and clasp beside To chan's wrist watch.

I'm registering the package so nothing will happen.

The weather lately has been very good. I hope it keeps up.
