Gee, but your letters sure take a long time to reach me. I hope after the Christmas rush it'll be better. All the boys are complaining because the letters take a long time to come here.

Let me know when the packages I sent reaches you. I hope the money order reaches you pretty soon.

We're going to movies tonight. I don't know what's playing yet.
