We went to a movie in Leghorn last night. We saw "Guest Wife". It was a comedy.

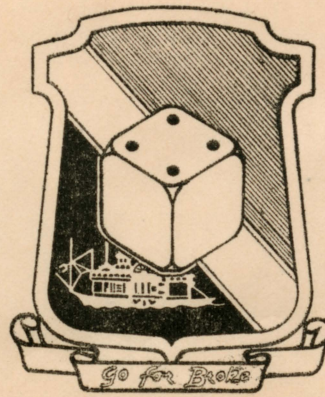
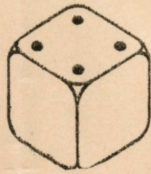
