Dear Mom and Pop,

This afternoon I received your letter and also my glasses. The glasses fits perfect. Thanks very much. Tonight I received another letter from you. This one is marked Oct 4. It had two pictures of us taken in Yosemite Park. If you take the pictures you wrote about, please send it to me when it's developed. I'll appreciate it very much. I'm trying to get my picture taken, but it's pretty hard.

Tomorrow we have inspection so we had to clean our hut.

We had our first try at the obstacle course today. Boy, am I pooped out. We had to go over walls, climb ropes, jump off platforms, and many other things. I'm glad tomorrow is a half a day.

I'm enclosing the camp paper in with the letter. On second thought, I'll send it separate because it might be too heavy for air mail and I want this letter to reach you for sure.
