I didn't get any letters today, but, then, no mail came in today so it's OK.

The weather seems to be getting warmer everyday. I guess it's pretty nice weather. Back home. Nothing like California weather.

I was paid \$52.60 this month but I actually got \$180 in liras. My wallet is pretty fat now.

The second battalion of our regiment was disbanded and the men were transferred to the 1st and the 3rd. I don't know why they did this but it may be a good sign. It's only my guess.

I have another picture I send you. I hope you have all the pictures I sent you since I came overseas. They'll be interesting to look at when I get home.

The other day I went into town and bought a reading lamp. I fixed a socket by my bed and so I have a dandy light to read by at night.
